The full name of Dr APJ Abdul Kalam was Avul Pakir Jainulabdeen Abdul Kalam. He is popularly known as the missile man of India and Peoples' President. He was born in a poor Tamil Muslim family on 15th of October in 1931 at Rameshwaram, Tamil Nadu district of Madras. He was completed

in science from St. Joseph's college in Tiruchirappalli And Aeronautical Engineering from the Madras Institute of Technology in 1954

He Joined the Defense Research And Development Organization (DRDO) as a scientist where he designed a small helicopter for the Indian Army later he joined the Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) His great contributions for the development of ballistic missiles in India He will be forever known as the "Missile Man of India," He wrote several Books India 2020 A vision for the new millennium (1988), wings of fire (1999), Ignited minds (2002), indomitable spirit of India etc

He served the country as 11th President of India from 2002 to 2007. He died on 27th of July 2015 (aged 83) in Meghalaya

Causes Reasons of farmers suicide in India

- ① Loan Disasters ⇒ as per the National Crime Records Bureau 2474 out of the recorded 3000 farmer suicide in 2015 had unpaid loans from Bank interestingly,

to Popular Perception only 98% of the loans were
for money lenders

- ② climate change → climate change is also Affecting farmers And Agriculture. uncertain monsoon systems, flash floods Etc Have led to crop losses Deffered monsoon.
- ③ lack of Awareness → while there are schemes And Policies Aimed at helping farmers And Agriculture. a lack of Awareness Pushed by the literacy And digital divide in india They Are unaware of the schemes or do not know how to avail of the benefits offered to them by the government.
- ④ rise in input costs → there has been an overall increase in Agriculture input costs. cost of seeds And chemicals like fertilizers And pesticides, cost of labour Etc
- * solutions to prevent farmer suicide in india
To overcome these problem first of all government should make sure that whatever subsidies And welfare schemes they announced it should be reach to the farmers of small villages
government should decrease the rate of interest

- (3) Medical licences must be Terminated with immediate effect for the practitioners who Are conducting female foeticide.
- (4) The Indian medical association Has Shouldered Efforts to prevent Prenatal sex determination By Promoting "Beti-Bachao, during it's meeting And Conferences.
- (5) The Dowry System one of the main causes of female foeticide should be Abolished from Society.
